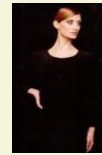

Genevieve Fortner trained with the Princeton Ballet School, Hartford Ballet School, The Martha Graham School of Contemporary Dance, Ballet Magnificat, and Le Centre de Formation Regional de la Danse in Nantes, France. She is a graduate of Belhaven University and danced with Hosanna Sacred Arts and Ballet Mississippi. Her performances include *The Nutcracker*, *Sleeping Beauty*, *Cinderella*, *Coppelia*, *Carmina Burana*, Mississippi Opera's *Orfeo ed Euridice*, and American Ballet Theatre's *Don Quixote*. She has taught ballet and modern at the University of Mississippi. She is the founder and director of Oxford Ballet School and serves as artistic advisor to the OxfordBalletAssociation,Inc.



David Arce- artistic director of Juline Regional Youth Ballet and a former San Francisco Ballet dancer.



Austin Finley- began his training at age 3 in his hometown of Clearwater, Fla. At age 9 he discovered a passion for ballet while performing as the Prince in *The Nutcracker* with the Miami City Ballet. Mr. Finley received further training with Lidia Fomina, Pavel Fomin, Suzanne Pomerantzeff, Sean Musselman, Mervet Elnabarawi and Wagih Aboella. He continued his studies with Chautauqua Institute, Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre, Miami City Ballet and the School of American Ballet. Mr. Finley competed in the Youth America Grand Prix Finals 2006 and was awarded a full scholarship to the Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis School at American Ballet Theatre where he trained with Franco De Vita. This is Mr. Finley's third season with BalletMet.



Erika Romanyuk- received her training under the direction of Jon Christifori. She has danced with Ballet Magnificat, Nashville Ballet, Atlanta Ballet, Hosanna Sacred Arts and Epiphany Dancers. Performances include *Serenade*, *The Four Temperments*, *Coppelia*, *Giselle*, *Paquita*, *Square Dance*, and was featured in soloist and principal roles in *The Nutcracker*, *Valse Fantasie*, *Swan Lake*, *Hallberg Suite* and various works by Jean-Pierre Bonnefoux and Paul Vasterling. She has taught at The School of Nashville Ballet and Hosanna Sacred Arts and directed a professional company called Ballet Liseaux in Nashville, Tennessee. She is currently founder & artistic director of Arizona Classical Ballet.
